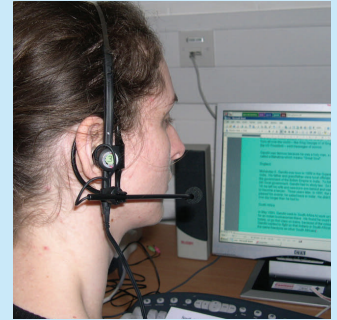

We can help you! Come to the LRC and make an appointment for a confidential chat.

What help is on offer?

Study support – help with reading, writing, maths, spelling and study skills.

Dyslexia assessment - we will help you to understand your dyslexia and give you help and advice.

Examination support – we will organise extra time or help with reading or writing in exams.

Computer support – we have computer programmes that can help you:

- Computer dictation software: you speak, it types!
- Screen-reader software which can read back your work, read handouts and read from the internet.

Equipment support – we can lend you a spellchecker, a keyboard, a dictaphone or a reading pen.

- We can give you a coloured plastic sheet to use when you are reading. This can make the print on the page clearer and easier to read.
