# LEARNING SUPPORT

Help with Maths





- Is it a long time since you did any maths and you just can't remember how to do it?
- Just joined a non-maths course but you have to do some maths?
- Is it all going a bit too fast for you?
- Getting anxious about getting behind?
- Do you feel that you need support to continue successfully?

### **How can I get additional learning support to help my maths?**

If your course does not have maths or numeracy as its main learning aim, you can ask your tutor to refer you to the Learning Support Team for maths support. We will discuss your learning needs with you and can then make an appointment to see you.

You can drop into the Learning Resource Centre where we're based and make an appointment to see a maths support tutor who will assess your needs.

### **What happens next?**

If it is agreed that you are eligible for additional learning support to help with maths or numeracy, we will agree on a support plan which will normally be a weekly support session with a maths tutor during term time.
